In August 2006, our mom, Jean Holzhuter, was diagnosed with stage four metastasized colon cancer and had to undergo a complete colostomy. At the age of 82, she had to learn to deal with this new physical condition. At first, she would not consider any type of treatment. Why prolong the inevitable? But then her doctor advised her to follow up with at least two to three months of radiation therapy to prevent this disease from recurring at a frantic, painful pace. Six months later, our father suffered a massive stroke.

In the months following, our mother got to the point where she was in so much pain she could no longer take care of herself, yet alone take care of our dad and his rehabilitation. We knew the cancer was progressing and Hospice of Salina was called in.

For the next year and a half, we watched our incredibly fun loving, active mother become bedridden. And through it all, she smiled and laughed and loved.

She moved on to her next big adventure on March 16, 2007.
